Judiciary of Guam Northern Court Satellite to Open for Limited Operations

August 28, 2020

(Hagatna, Guam) – In line with the various executive orders issued by Governor Lourdes Leon Guerrero, including Executive Order No. 2020-29 issued on August 27, 2020, the Supreme Court of Guam has issued several administrative orders to protect the public health, the most recent of which is its Sixth Updated Order, Administrative Order No. ADM20-403 issued on August 28, 2020.

The court recognizes that the growing number of confirmed COVID-19 cases in Guam and its resulting strain on the island's healthcare system require continued efforts to limit the transmission of the disease. At the same time, the court recognizes that it must expand its services to the extent possible, keeping at the forefront the need to protect the health and safety of court employees, patrons, and the general public.

Consistent with the Sixth Updated Order, ADM 20-403, beginning August 31, 2020, the Northern Court Satellite in Dededo shall be open to the public from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, for a limited set of transactions, namely:

- a. Payment of traffic citations;
- b. Payment of case-related obligations, including bail, restitution, and fines and fees; and
- c. Requests for traffic clearances and court clearances (including clearances required by government institutions or the private sector for employment purposes, clearances for candidates required by the Guam Election Commission, etc.)

These transactions can also be requested and paid online at www.guamcourts.org. To avoid long lines and wait times at the Northern Court Satellite, court patrons are encouraged to contact the court to make an appointment if they need assistance with any of the above transactions.
