NOTE: Rule-making authority cited for the formulation of procedures governing the review of existing institutional health services in terms of their appropriateness by the Guam Health Planning & Development Agency, 10 GCA §5103. These Rules and Regulations were filed with the Legislative Secretary on August 26, 1983.

The regulations of the Guam Health Planning & Development Agency are reprinted here in form as exact as possible to those filed with the Legislative Secretary. The substance of the regulations has not been changed. However, for the purpose of uniformity and ease of use, a new system of numbering has been adopted by the Editor.

The Guam Health Planning Agency has been abolished, after being [placed in 17 GCA Chapter 41, Article in the 24th Guam Legislature. The agency and its functions were abolished by P.L. 26-76-55. Therefore, the rules, and those published as Chapter 31 of this Title will not be published as there is no longer any reason to do so.

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
