§ 33101. Submission of Budget.

Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Board *shall* submit its annual operating budget and such capital improvement budgets as it finds necessary directly to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* no later than the fifteenth (15th) day of February of every year.

§ 33102. Construction with Other Law.

Except as expressly provided for herein and notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the College shall be autonomous and self-sufficient in matters pertaining to its governance, organization and administration and the promulgation of its rules and regulations, in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law (5 GCA Chapter 9) pertaining to the following:

- (1) courses of instruction;
- (2) issuance of certificates, diplomas, credits and degrees;
- (3) personnel recruitment, appointment, tenure, promotion, dismissal and other personnel matters;
- (4) obligation and disposition of funds, provided that appropriated funds are used for the purpose or purposes stipulated in the Act appropriating said funds; and
- (5) soliciting, receiving and using gifts of any kind whatsoever for the purposes provided in this Chapter.

§ 33103. Campuses.

The Guam Vocational- Technical High School campus located in the municipality of Mangilao is hereby designated the campus and principal

office of the Guam Community College. There may be such additional campuses as the Board shall provide.

§ 33104. Truck Driver Program.

(a) Truck driving training loans. A truck driving training loan program (the *Loan Program*) is hereby established for each student accepted into the Guam Community College truck driving training course. Such student may apply for a Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) training loan if the applicant has taken and passed the "C" motor vehicle license written examination given by the License and Registration Section of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. Such loan shall fund the borrower's expenses during the period of training, but loan funds shall only be advanced in increments as needed to fund current tuition or expenses for training, equipment and accessories as verified by the Guam Community College. No funds shall be advanced unless the student is in the process of attending classes, and is continuing to attend classes until the program is completed. Should a student cease to attend classes, loan advances shall cease and pro-rated unused loan portions previously advanced shall be returned to the Guam Community College. If the borrower graduates from the truck driving training course and is thereafter employed as a truck or tractor driver for at least one (1) year, such loan shall be considered a grant. The Guam Community College, pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law, shall establish rules and regulations on collateral necessary to obtain loans under the Loan Program, and the repayment of loans not deemed grants.0

(b) Termination of Loan Program. The Loan Program shall terminate on June 30, 1997, except that those students whose training loans have been approved prior to such date shall be permitted to utilize their loan to complete their training, subject to the provisions of subparagraph (a) of this section.
