**§ 33101. Submission of Budget.**

Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the Board *shall* submit its annual operating budget and such capital improvement budgets as it finds necessary directly to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than* the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) day of February of every year.

**§ 33102. Construction with Other Law.**

Except as expressly provided for herein and notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the College shall be autonomous and self-sufficient in matters pertaining to its governance, organization and administration and the promulgation of its rules and regulations, in accordance with the Administrative Adjudication Law (5 GCA Chapter 9) pertaining to the following:

- (a) courses of instruction;
- (b) issuance of certificates, diplomas, credits and degrees;
- (c) personnel recruitment, appointment, tenure, promotion, dismissal and other personnel matters;
- (d) obligation and disposition of funds, provided that appropriated funds are used for the purpose or purposes stipulated in the Act appropriating said funds; and

(e) soliciting, receiving and using gifts of any kind whatsoever for the purposes provided in this Chapter.

**§ 33103. Campuses.**

The Guam Vocational- Technical High School campus located in the municipality of Mangilao is hereby designated the campus and principal office of the Guam Community College. There may be such additional campuses as the Board shall provide.

**§ 33105. Procurement Authority.**

The College is authorized to promulgate its own services, supplies, and construction procurement regulations pursuant to Title 5 GCA, §§ 5125, 5131, 5030 (k) and (q), 5120, 5302(b) and (c), 5304(b), 5306(d), and 5307.

The procurement laws and regulations established in Guam's Procurement law, found in Title 5 GCA, Chapter 5, and 2 G.A.R. Division 4 *shall* be used by GCC in the procurement of all services, supplies, and construction procurement contracts. The College will use the laws and regulations established in Title 5 GCA, Chapter 5, and 2 G.A.R. Division 4 as its own regulations unless and until the Board of Trustees approves different or additional procurement regulations.

The College will employ its own Chief Procurement Officer, who will serve as the procurement officer for all supplies, services, and construction contracts for the College.

The College may, upon the Board of Trustee's approval, delegate its procurement authority of construction contracts to the Department of Public Works.

The College may, upon the Board of Trustee's approval, delegate its procurement authority of services and supplies contracts to the General Service Agency.

**§ 33106. [Untitled].**

Authorization of the College to enter into a renewable lease agreement with Guam Power Authority in order to develop educational opportunities to train workers for the emerging technologies related to sustainable and renewable energy.

(a) *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) hereby grants the College, pursuant to Title 1 GCA, §1800, the authority to enter into this lease agreement with GPA.

(b) *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) hereby grants the College, pursuant to Title 21 GCA, §60112, the authority for the College to enter into this lease agreement with GPA.

(c) *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) hereby grants the College, pursuant to Title 2 GCA, §2107, an exception for the College to enter into this lease agreement with GPA, without requiring a separate piece of legislation.

(d) *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) intends for this statute to supersede any and all related statutes that would otherwise impede the College's ability to enter into this lease agreement with GPA.

(e) The lease *shall* be subject to legislative approval in accordance with the AAA process.
