NOTE: The Guam Visitors Bureau was reorganized by P.L. 17-32. As a result of that law, none of its by-laws, personnel rules and regulations or grant applications, are, in the opinion of the GVB, subject to the Administrative Adjudication Act. Therefore, none have been submitted to the Legislature under that Act. Since this publication only contains rules subject to the Administrative Adjudication Act, none of the GVB policies, etc., will be published here. Such policies, by-laws, rules and grant applications may be had from the Guam Visitors Bureau, itself.

As a result of that reorganization, the GVB no longer licenses tour guides. Therefore the relevant rules will be deleted from this publication.

Law creating the GVB may be found in 12 GCA Chapter 9.

CHAPTER 4
Zoonosis Control Section
(Department of Public Health and Social Services)

NOTE: Rule-making authority cited for the formulation of regulations relative to the entry to, release from and duration of quarantine for dogs and cats entering Guam by the Department of Food and Agriculture, 10 GCA §34111.

Enforcement of these regulations is the responsibility of the Zoonosis Control Section of the Department of Public Health and Social Services as provided in 10 GCA Chapter 34, Article 1.

Rule-making authority cited for formulation of regulations for the Zoonosis control section of the Department of Public Health and Social Services by the Director of Public Health and Social Services, 10 GCA Chapter 34.
