Private Process Server Program Application Requirements

Minimum Qualifications

- ➢ 18 yrs. or older
- Resident of Guam (at least 1 yr. immediately preceding the application)
- Must not be convicted of any felony, or of a misdemeanor involving fraud and dishonesty, unless such felony or misdemeanor conviction occurred over ten (10) years before the date of application is submitted.

Fees

- \$75.00 for Training/Examination/Material Cost. (For Government and Private Process Servers)
- \$300.00 filing fee for the Annual Standard Certification (For Private Process Servers)

Required Documents to be emailed with the application to the Special Process Server Program Coordinator at <u>enaputi@guamcourts.gov</u>

- Application
- Photo of the applicant (e.g., a passport-style photo or any recent photo with a light-colored background)
- Guam Business License (*Required for Private Process Servers*)
- Declaration stating the applicant is a legal resident of Guam for at least one year leading up to the date of application.
- Declaration stating that the applicant will well and faithfully serve process in accordance with the law, and otherwise comply with all laws of Guam and regulations of the Judiciary of Guam.
- Declaration stating that the applicant has no felony or misdemeanor convictions involving fraud and dishonesty.
- Petition for Appointment of Special Process Server
- Provisional Certification (The Annual Standard Certification form will be required upon the successful completion of the Training and Examination)
