


**BEFORE THE 2004 JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM**  
**RESOLUTION NO. JC04-005**  
**RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A NEW**  
**JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF GUAM**

**WHEREAS**, on February 7, 2004, the Honorable Joaquin V.E. Manibusan resigned his appointment as Superior Court Judge in order to become Magistrate of the District Court of Guam; and


**WHEREAS**, the Superior Court operations are impacted by the vacancy and require another full-time Judge be appointed and undergo the advice and consent process so that the business of the Judiciary and its services to the people not be adversely affected.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that pursuant to 7 GCA § 4101(c) (as amended by P.L. 27-31), the Chief Justice of Guam is hereby authorized to request the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, Governor of Guam, to appoint a new Judge of the Superior Court of Guam to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of the Honorable Joaquin V.E. Manibusan.
