**WHEREAS,** On April 30, 2004, this Judicial Council adopted its Resolution JC04-009 thereby accepting the Public Defender Service Corporation's proposal for the establishment of the Alternative Public Defender; and

**WHEREAS,** an Agreement to Provide Attorney Services for Indigent Defendants was entered into between this Judicial Council and the Public Defender Service Corporation on June 15, 2004 for the term covering October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005 which also provided for renewal prior to the Agreement's expiration date upon the written consent of both parties; and

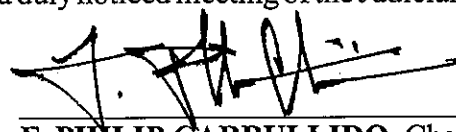
**WHEREAS,** the Agreement was thereafter extended to cover the period from October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006; and

**WHEREAS,** the Public Defender Service Corporation, in contemplation of again extending the Agreement to cover the period from October 1, 2006 to September 30, 2007, submitted a proposed Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request regarding the Alternative Public Defender office, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, to this Judicial Council for its consideration at its regularly scheduled meeting on July 20, 2006; and

**WHEREAS,** the Judicial Council duly considered and approved the proposed Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request at its July 20, 2006 meeting;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that the decision of the Judicial Council on July 20, 2006 approving the Public Defender Service Corporation's proposed Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request for the Alternative Public Defender office, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, is **HEREBY RATIFIED.**

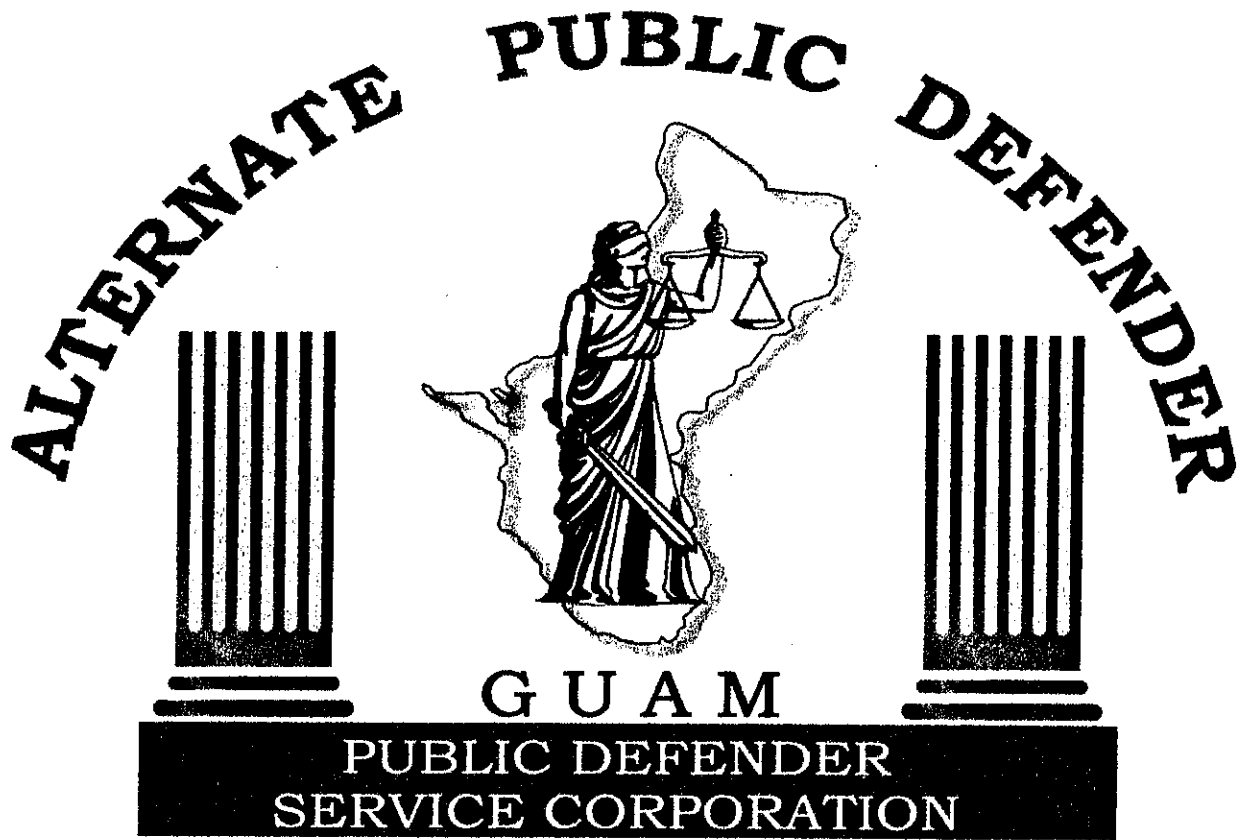

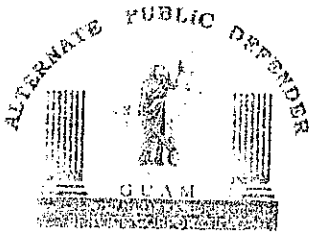

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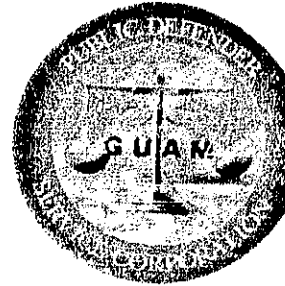

Dear Chief Justice Carbullido:

Submitted herewith for your review is the Alternate Public Defender's (APD) Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request.

As you know, the office of the APD was established in October 2004 as a subsidiary of the Public Defender Service Corporation in response to various concerns regarding the rapidly climbing costs of indigent defense. Since our inception, our focus has remained on providing quality legal services to eligible clients while simultaneously containing the costs of doing so.

The following is a summary of our budget request:

**\$ 599,938**

There will be no increases in staffing levels for Fiscal Year 2007. However, increases in the object category of personnel services are due to salary increments that will become due during the fiscal year, the accrual of lump sum annual leave payments which must be recorded pursuant to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles and GASB 34, and the required recognition of a liability for employees' unused accumulated sick leave (those under the Defined Contribution Plan).

Unfortunately, this office has not been spared from the continuous increases in the general costs of living and doing business that our island faces today. We are ever-mindful of the need to contain costs, and therefore do what we can to conserve and curtail unnecessary expenditures. The cost of our operations remains minimal; increases can be attributed to inflationary costs of goods and supplies.

Please note that the government's share for retirement contributions, life, health and dental insurances are based on percentages currently in effect. Should enabling legislation for Fiscal Year 2007 mandate increases in these areas, we will be requesting a supplemental budget to cover these costs for this period.

**This Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request was approved by the PDSC Board of Trustees at a duly-noticed meeting on June 13, 2006.**

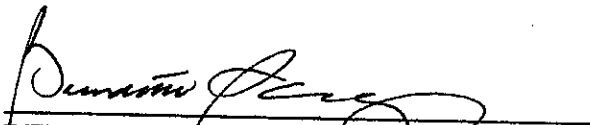
- WHEREAS,** Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) Board of Trustees Resolution No. 08-04 established the office of the Alternate Public Defender (APD) as a separate section/division of the PDSC, answerable to the PDSC Board of Trustees and subject to funding by the Judicial Client Service Fund under the stewardship of the Judicial Council of Guam; and
- WHEREAS,** On June 15, 2004 an Agreement to Provide Attorney Services For Indigent Defendants was executed by and between the PDSC and the Judicial Council of Guam through the Administrator of the Courts, which, among others, provided for the funding of this program from October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005; and
- WHEREAS,** As provided for by Section Four of the above-described Agreement allowing for renewals prior to the expiration date subject to the written consent of both parties, on September 28, 2005 an Agreement To Provide Attorney Services for Indigent Defendants was executed, thereby extending funding for this program throughout Fiscal Year 2006; and
- WHEREAS,** In order to extend the services rendered by the APD into the next fiscal year, and to allow for the renewal of the Agreement to Provide Attorney Services For Indigent Defendants, a budget plan must be submitted for consideration and approval by the PDSC Board of Trustees; and
- WHEREAS,** The Alternate Public Defender, by and through its Supervising Attorney and the Director of the Public Defender Service Corporation, presented the APD's Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request of **\$599,938** to the PDSC Board of Trustees; and
- WHEREAS,** The Board of Trustees finds this budget request appropriate and adequate to carry out the APD's mission in Fiscal Year 2007; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED,** The Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation, at its meeting of June 13, 2006, hereby approves the APD Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request of **\$599,938**, with all provisions contained therein being attached hereto and made a part of this resolution.

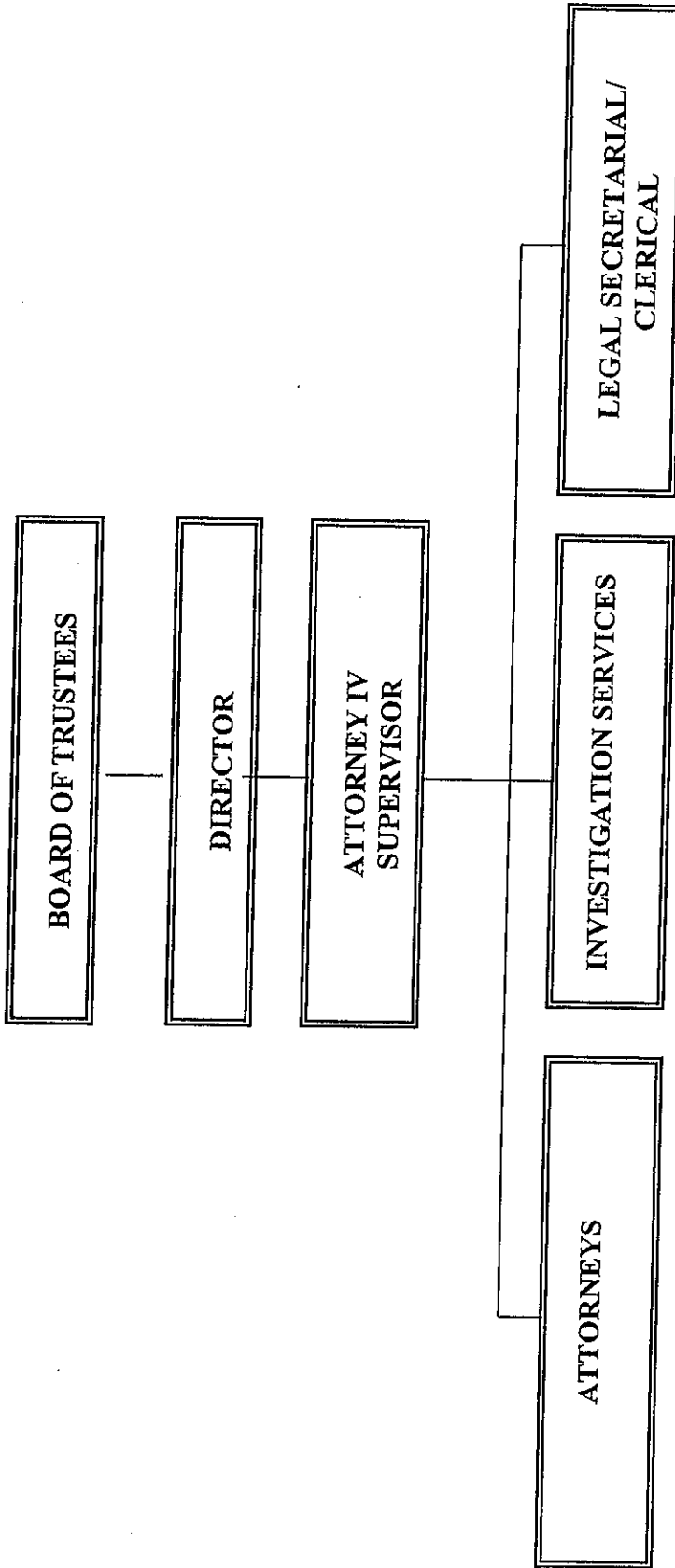

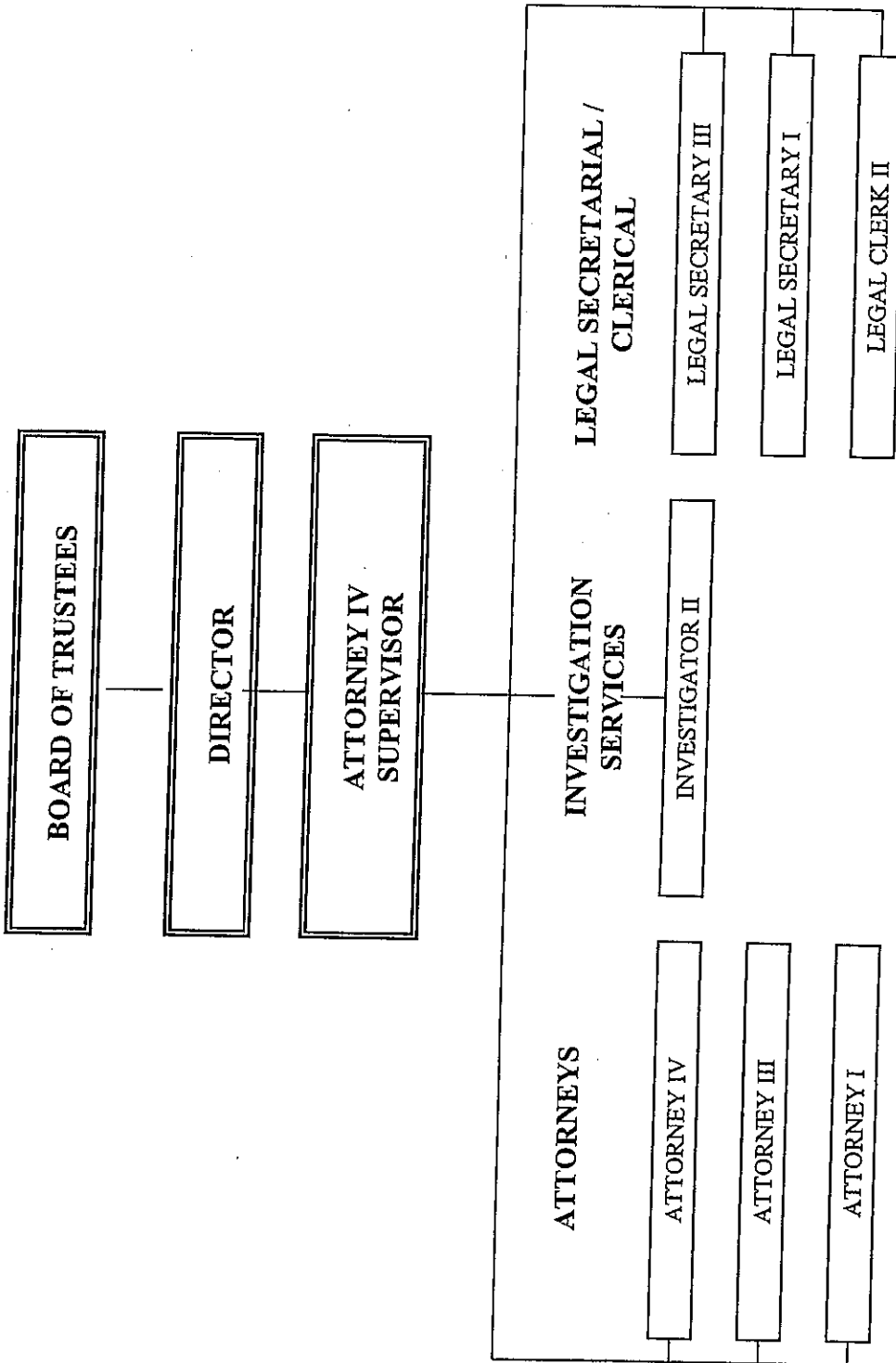

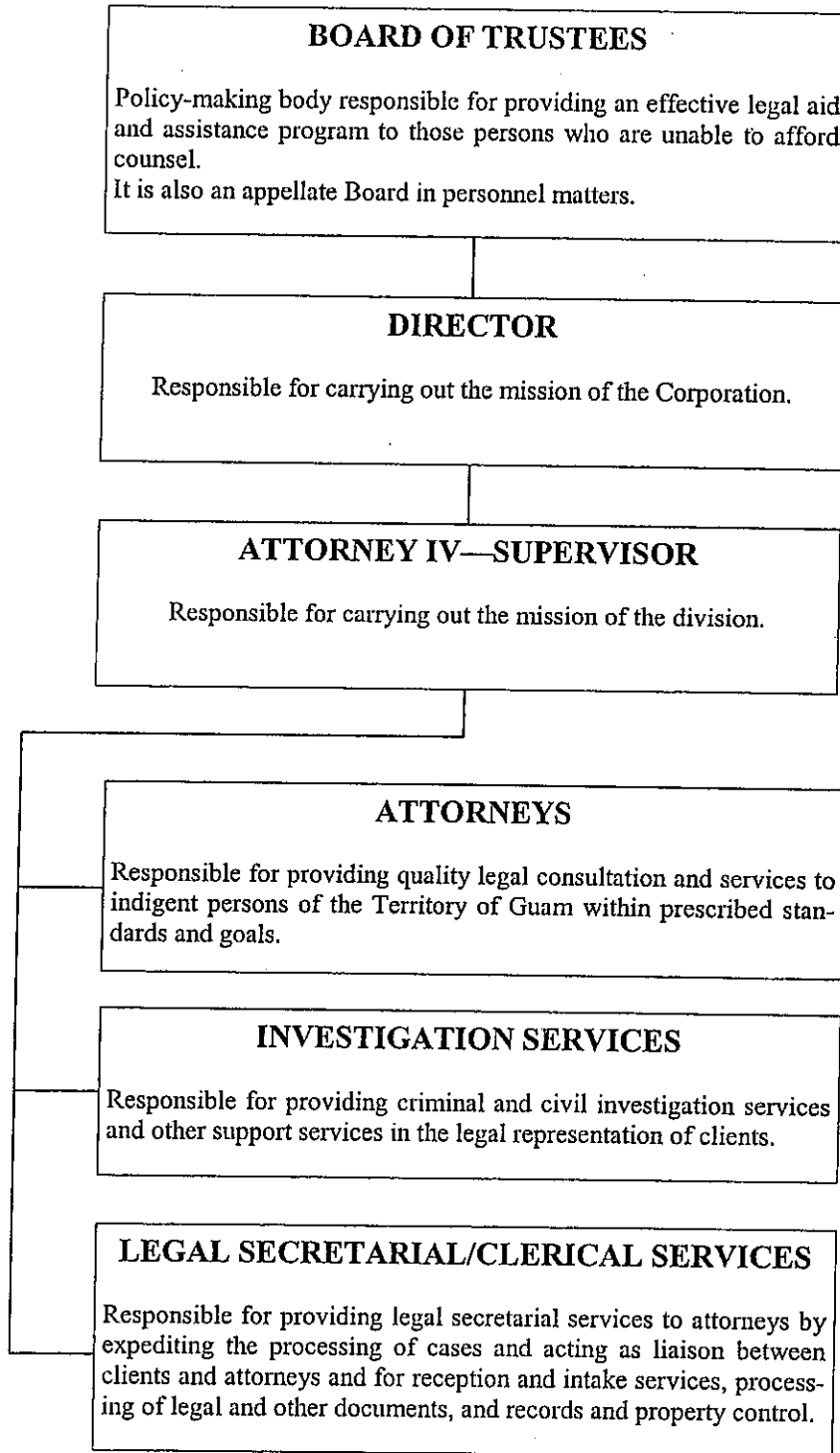

**FUNCTION:**           **Judiciary/Legal Defense**

**AGENCY:**           **Alternate Public Defender**  
                          **(A Division of the Public Defender Service Corporation)**

**MISSION STATEMENT:**

The Alternate Public Defender (APD) exists to provide effective legal assistance to those unable to afford private counsel, thereby ensuring equal protection of their lawful rights, in accordance with prescribed ethics, laws, rules and regulations, who have been refused services by the Public Defender Service Corporation (PDSC) due to conflicts of interest, or have had the APD appointed as their legal counsel by the courts of Guam.

**GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:**

The office of the Alternate Public Defender was established upon the recommendation of the Subcommittee on Indigent Defense, under the chairmanship of Associate Justice Frances Tydingco-Gatewood, as a means of improving, while simultaneously decreasing the costs of indigent defense. The financial burden of providing constitutionally mandated legal representation in criminal cases surfaced when costs associated with this service began to exceed \$1,000,000 at a time when the island of Guam was in economic turmoil due to decreasing revenues. After conducting research and developing a proposal in this matter, on April 21, 2004 the Board of Trustees of the Public Defender Service Corporation approved the establishment of the Alternate Public Defender as a division of the PDSC.

As such, the APD seeks to provide quality legal services to its clients in cases which the PDSC must withdraw from due to conflicts of interest. As Guam continues to experience economic hardships, many of the island's residents become desperate in their attempts to provide for their family's basic needs, and unfortunately resort to illegal measures for survival.

Statistical reports for the first year of operations for the APD (October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005), indicate a total of 556 cases received. For Fiscal Year 2006, the division is projected to have a similar caseload, based on the numbers experienced from October 1, 2005 through March 31, 2006. Although the division's Fiscal Year 2007 Budget Request reflects an increase of approximately \$20,400 from that of Fiscal Year 2006, the total cost remains economically advantageous to the government, when compared to the amount in excess of \$1,000,000 transmitted to Associated Defense Advocates for this purpose during a previous twelve-month period.

For FY2007, the APD will continue to provide efficient and cost-effective services in the realm of

legal assistance/services.

**IMPACT STATEMENT:**

It is imperative that the requested amount of \$599,938 for Fiscal Year 2007 be approved and released as scheduled, so that the division can carry out its mission of providing legal services to qualified clients. The success of this program and our concerted efforts to reduce the cost of providing counsel for indigent defense is incumbent upon the financial support of the Judicial Council of Guam through the Client Services Fund which is under their stewardship.

**AGENCY BUDGET PLAN:**

Personnel costs will increase in FY2007, due to the newly-established Attorney Pay Schedule which became mandatory for all government attorneys, as well as salary increments for eligible employees. In addition, employer contributions for retirement, life, medical and dental insurance rates are also expected to increase and must be funded. Therefore, any reduction in the budgetary request for FY2007 will require corresponding reductions in the level of services provided.

For Fiscal Year 2007, the APD seeks to retain its current staffing level. The rental agreement for APD's current facilities provides for an annual renewal at the present rate. Despite the rising costs of living, APD's budgetary needs for next fiscal year remain consistently cost-effective, in line with the program's goals of providing indigent defense at lower costs to the people of Guam.

**PROGRAM PURPOSE:**

To provide effective legal services to the indigent people of Guam, as set forth in 12 G.C.A, Chapter 11 (the Public Defender Service Corporation Act of 1975 and Resolution No. 08-04).

**IMPACT STATEMENT:**

The Alternate Public Defender (APD) attorneys (Assistant Alternate Public Defender) provide effective legal consultation and services to indigent persons of the island of Guam within prescribe ethics, standards and goals.

In order to carry out the mission of the APD in providing these services, and to comply with the guidelines set forth in the Guam Bar Code of Ethics and the APD Standards and Goals relative to the recommended caseload per attorney, per year, adequate staffing levels and support services are imperative.

**PROGRAM BUDGET:**

Assistant Alternate Public Defenders are responsible for providing professional, legal services to the indigent people of Guam in both criminal and civil proceedings (as defined by law). These services must comply with ethical standards established for legal professionals in terms of caseloads and/or the number of clients represented at a given time.

In order to meet the needs of our clientele and to provide an ethical level of service, the retention of all current attorney positions is essential.

**GOALS:**

- A. To defend indigent persons charges in criminal cases before the courts of Guam. (The determination as to whether a defendant is indigent and whether the case is to be referred to the Corporation shall be at the discretion of the judge before whom such defendant is appearing.)

- B. To render legal aid and assistance to those persons in Guam who, under rules established by the Corporation, are in need of legal assistance and representation and who are unable to afford an attorney in private practice. (The Corporation shall not compete with attorneys engaged in private practice of law in Guam and shall give legal assistance in civil matters only to those who would otherwise not receive such assistance.)

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

##### **A. In Criminal Matters:**

As set forth in 8 G.C.A Sections 45.30 and 45.40, if the Court finds that a person is financially unable to employ counsel, the APD will be appointed for the defendant unless APD declines the appointment due to a conflict or other appropriate reason. The same rule applies to appointment for juveniles or other individuals in juvenile matters. Upon being appointed counsel in a criminal matter, **an Assistant Alternate Public Defender will ensure that the defendant's right to due process and other constitutional, statutory and/or procedural guarantees are afforded.**

This same rule applies to appointments for juveniles or other individuals in juvenile matters.

##### **B. In Civil and Domestic Matters:**

The Court has also the power to appoint the APD in certain civil and domestic matters such as assigning counsel as Guardian Ad litem in child or adult abuse cases, child custody situations and guardianships and counsel who may be appointed for persons charged with criminal contempt in civil and domestic matters. (The court discretion also applies to the United States District Court of Guam.) The APD is obligated to appear in such matters without regard to its own rules and regulations. Therefore, **the APD is obligated to appear by order of the appointing court, with the objective of obeying the orders of the court as long as they do not place the APD in unethical situations, and then seek withdrawal from representation by motion to the respective court.**

##### **C. Other Legal Matter:**

Except for those civil matters noted above, those that the APD can handle are essentially at the discretion of the Board of Trustees under 12 G.C.A Section 11105, as long as the Board follows the restrictions stated above with regard to the person being unable to afford an attorney in private practice and that legal assistance is not available otherwise.

FUNCTION:           Judicial

PROGRAM:           **Investigative Services**

**PROGRAM PURPOSE:**

To provide technical assistance to attorneys in the preparation of client cases by conducting research and investigative activities.

**IMPACT STATEMENT:**

Investigative services provide the attorneys with critical information to serve as the basis for appropriate course of action in the representation of clients.

In order to provide this technical support services to the attorneys, staffing levels and minimal fiscal support such as office supplies, communication equipment, and local travel mileage reimbursement are vital in accomplishing investigative services.

**PROGRAM BUDGET PLAN:**

This division is responsible for providing for providing the necessary information (evidence, witness statements, sketches, photos, drawings, etc.), to be used in court by attorneys for respective cases. In order to meet the demands involved in case preparation, witness interviews, the collection of evidential data, and a recent practice of magistrate's hearings occurring on weekends, the number of staff investigators must remain consistent.

**GOALS:**

To provide substantive information to attorneys in the management of a case.

**OBJECTIVES:**

- Conduct interviews with clients, witnesses, victims and third party custodians.
- Research, obtain and secure evidence.

- Testify in court.
- Serve Subpoenas
- Obtain victim waivers.
- Refer clients to appropriate agencies/organizations according to their needs.

**MEASURES:**

- Number of cases investigated
- Number of interviews conducted
- Number of appearances in court
- Number of victim's waivers obtained
- Number of referrals made

**PROGRAM:**          Legal Secretarial Services

**PROGRAM PURPOSE:**

This division provides legal secretarial services to attorneys, expedites the processing of cases and is the liaison between clients and their attorneys.

**IMPACT STATEMENT:**

The Legal Secretarial Services Division provides efficient and direct clerical and secretarial support to the attorneys and the general clientele.

In order to maintain efficient clerical and secretarial services, staffing levels are critical to accomplishing the goals and objectives of the office of the Alternate Public Defender. The continuous operation of the computer system and other office equipment (i.e., copying machine, facsimile, telephone system) is vital in accomplishing the goals and objectives of this division.

**PROGRAM BUDGET PLAN:**

The Legal Secretarial Services Division is responsible for providing legal secretarial services to attorneys in areas of case management and processing, coordinating and handling communications between the attorneys, the general clientele and other divisions within the Alternate Public Defender.

**GOALS:**

- A.    To provide clerical and secretarial support to the attorneys in an efficient and professional manner
- B.    To provide constant effective communications with the attorneys, clients, other office personnel and the general public

**OBJECTIVES:**

1. To provide direct clerical and secretarial support to the attorneys
2. To provide effective communications between the attorneys, the general clientele and other personnel within the agency
3. To provide efficient services to the general clientele
4. To provide an effective means of case facilitation, particularly with optimal usage of the ABACUS system of case management

**MEASURES:**

- Number of cases received and referred to the attorneys
- Number and quality of documents typed and the ability to determine the proper document to be prepared
- Number of telephonic contacts made with efficiency and courtesy

**PROGRAM PURPOSE:**

This division provides initial eligibility determination of potential clients as mandated by law for legal representation and performs administrative support services such as reception, telephone operation, and receipt and delivery of documents. Additionally, this section provides for the management of client records and the inventory and accountability of APD office equipment and property.

**IMPACT STATEMENT:**

This section is critical in order to provide efficient services to the public and administrative services to the overall mission of the APD. Without this section, professional, technical and administrative support staff would be barraged with unrelated time-consuming tasks.

In order to comply with the Records Management Act (Article 6, 5 G.C.A.) and Public Defender Service Corporation Board of Trustees Resolution No. PDSC 95094, and certain accounting principles involving the inventory and accountability of government property, this program is crucial. Otherwise, the APD and the PDSC would be liable for legal action insofar as efficient case management and property inventory are involved.

**PROGRAM BUDGET PLAN:**

The Legal Clerical Services division is responsible for controlling and managing the daily reception of those seeking the services of the APD, the coordination of telephone communications, and incoming and outgoing documents. Furthermore, it is responsible for establishing and maintaining an efficient and effective records management program, as well as accounting for all official equipment and property.

**GOALS:**

- Implement efficient and effective public reception procedures
- Establish client case file system
- Ensure that those seeking APD assistance meet the mandated eligibility requirements
- Establish an efficient telephone communication system
- Establish and maintain an effective document receipt and delivery system
- Establish and maintain a records management system that provides for the filing, retrieving and disposing of client records
- Establish and maintain a property control system for APD office equipment and property

**OBJECTIVES:**

- To receive the public and respond to inquiries or refer them to appropriate personnel or establishments
- To conduct interviews to determine the nature of a case, eligibility for services and any potential conflict of interest
- To prepare new case files and enter client information in the case management system
- To receive and respond to inquiries or forward incoming telephone calls to appropriate personnel
- To receive and acknowledge all incoming documents through personal delivery or the mail system; distribute documents to appropriate personnel; file legal documents in court
- To file clients' case files in accordance with established procedure
- Retrieve case files as requested
- Provide adequate storage space for files
- Update client information on client database system
- Maintain an office equipment and property inventory system and conduct visual inventory of all APD office equipment and property

**FOOTNOTES:**

**Note 1:** For Fiscal Year 2007, funding for the Alternate Public Defender will come from the Judicial Client Services Fund under the stewardship of the Judicial Council.

**Note 2:** Public Law 26-86 provides that upon retirement under the Defined Contribution (DC) plan, 50% of the employees' unused accumulated sick leave shall be paid in cash. GASB Statement No. 16 requires that a liability be recognized if sick leave or other compensated absences are earned by employees and that it is probable that the employer will compensate its employees by cash payments at termination or retirement.

Therefore, the estimated amounts of \$13,889 for annual leave and \$5,835 for sick leave were included in FY 2006 expenditures under Regular Salaries for this purpose. An estimated shortfall of \$13,729 is anticipated under this category due to the following: \$435 for annual leave accrual, \$5,835 for sick leave accrual (under-budgeted in FY 2006), and \$7,459 in government mandated increases for GovGuam Retirement, Medical, Life and DC D&D contributions.

**Note 3:** Increases in personnel services can be attributed to Attorneys' pay adjustment and salary increments as mandated by PL 27-106 due in FY 2007 for eligible attorneys and staff, and increases in Retirement contributions, Medical, DC D&D and Life Insurances not included in the FY 2006 budget request.

A year end annual leave accrual adjustment (estimated at \$5,590) and year end sick leave accrual adjustment (estimated at \$2,644) is also proposed to reflect leave balances at the close of the fiscal year.

**Note 4:** Increases in contractual services is for the request to upgrade the copy machine lease. APD is currently leasing a desktop which is used for copying, faxing, printing, and scanning. The current machine is not meeting the demands of their workload (they average 5,800 prints per month).
