





**BEFORE THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OF GUAM  
RESOLUTION NO. JC 06-021**


**RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING A DANGKULU NA SI YU'US MA'ASE TO  
MARSHAL OF THE COURTS PITO QUINATA CRUZ FOR EXEMPLARY  
PUBLIC SERVICE TO THE PEOPLE OF GUAM AND THE GUAM JUDICIARY**


- WHEREAS, Pito Quinata Cruz embarked on his service to the People of Guam and our island community in 1977, as a member of the island's law enforcement community with the Department of Corrections until 1978 when he transferred to the Department of Public Works; and
- WHEREAS, Pito Quinata Cruz returned to law enforcement on February 3, 1980 by joining the island's Judiciary as a Court Security Officer, and beginning a long and stellar career with the courts of Guam; and
- WHEREAS, Pito Quinata Cruz tirelessly worked his way up through the ranks of the Judiciary's Marshal service for nearly two and half decades by serving with dedication, commitment, and professionalism, as evidenced by his well-deserved promotions and record of achievements; and
- WHEREAS, Pito Quinata Cruz crowned his Marshal service and career by being appointed as the first Marshal of the Courts for the Unified Judiciary by Chief Justice F. Philip Carbullido; and unanimously endorsed by the Judicial Council of Guam on June 17, 2004; and
- WHEREAS, since assuming that leadership position within the Judiciary, Marshal of the Courts Cruz has led and helped in the consolidation, reorganization, development and implementation of reforms and efficiencies for the Marshals Division and the Judicial Branch;
- WHEREAS, Marshal of the Courts Cruz will have devoted 30 years of public service and his life to the People of Guam on September 29, 2006; and
- WHEREAS, Marshal of the Courts Cruz has tendered his intent to retire full-time from his position and public service on that date.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Judiciary of Guam express utmost gratitude and appreciation to Marshal of the Courts Cruz for his dedicated, and loyal service to the Justices, Judges, Marshals Division, Judiciary management, Judiciary employees, and the People of Guam; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Marshal of the Courts Cruz be honored for his commitment and dedication to public service.
