§ 15101. Recognized Political Party - National Convention.

§ 15101. Recognized Political Party - National Convention.

A recognized political party, affiliated with a national political party which holds a convention for the purpose of nominating candidates for President of the United States shall select delegates and alternates to such national convention. Such delegates and alternates from the recognized political party shall be chosen in the exact number authorized by the rules of such national political party.

§ 15102. Selection of Delegates.

Delegates and alternates from the recognized political party to the national convention of such party shall be selected by such recognized political party at a convention called by the Chairman at least thirty (30) days before the date set for such national convention. The local convention of such recognized political party shall consist of such party members, and shall choose such delegates and alternates, as well as national committeeman and national committeewoman, in such manner, as is authorized by the rules or bylaws of such recognized political party.
